Canada

- NOV Real GDP grew 0.4%
- JAN Markit Mfg PMI was another 1.2 points due to growing output and new orders

United States

- JAN Non-farm Payrolls grew by 200K, higher than consensus, with JAN Unemployment Rate holding at 4.1%
- DEC ISM Mfg Index fell 0.2 points
- DEC Savings Rate was essentially unchanged at 2.4%
- DEC Construction Spending was up 0.7% m/m and DEC Factory Orders also up 1.7%
- Q4 Employment Cost Index grew 0.6% q/q

Eurozone

- Q4 GDP rose to 2.3% with Q4 Unemployment Rate staying at 8.7%

Japan

- DEC Unemployment Rate moved up to 2.8%

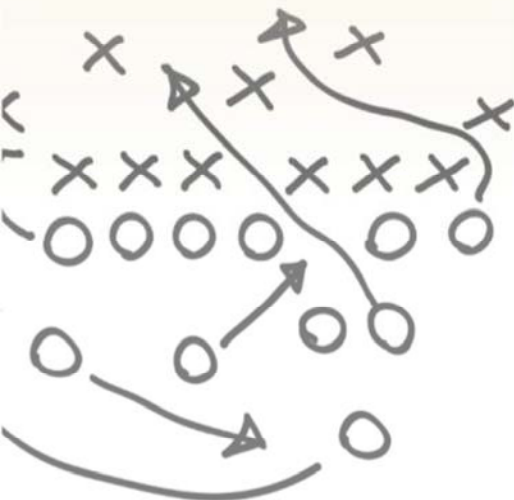
