# Coaches Corner

Last week, the S&P/TSX Composite Index increased 1.12% while the S&P 500 fell (0.54%). Year-to-date the S&P/TSX Composite has now decreased (0.29%) while the S&P 500 has now increased 1.47%.

The Health Care Sector led the way for the S&P/TSX last week increasing by 6.31%, while the Utilities Sector was the weakest sector falling (0.92%) on the week.

### **MARKET NEWS**

#### Canada

The Consumer price index rose 0.1% in April in seasonally adjusted terms causing the year-on-year inflation rate to decline to 2.2%.

Retail Sales increased 0.6% in March to C\$50.2 billion. Sales increased in 6 of the 11 categories surveyed including a 3.0% gain in the motor vehicles/parts segment.

The Teranet-National Bank Composite House Price Index In April, the rose 0.2% m/m. Eight of the 11 constituent metropolitan areas swung upward, led by Quebec City (+1.5%), Hamilton (+0.8%), and Halifax (+0.6%).

#### **United States**

In April retail sales rose 0.3%. Sales of motor vehicles and parts inched up 0.1%. Excluding this category, sales still advanced 0.3% thanks to gains for clothing, furniture, gasoline stations, and miscellaneous items.

Housing Starts fell (3.7%) in April to 1.287K in annualized terms after reaching their highest level since the recession the previous month. While single-family starts were generally unchanged at 894K, multi-unit starts fell (11.3%) to 393K.
