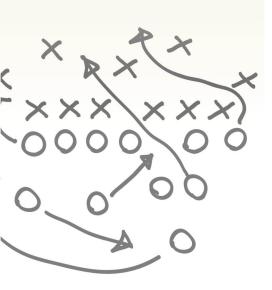

Coaches Corner

Last week, the S&P/TSX Composite Index lost (0.57%) while the S&P 500 also decreased (0.25%). Year-to-date the S&P/TSX Composite has increased 0.72% while the S&P 500 has now increased 5.97.

The Info Tech Sector led the way for the S&P/TSX last week increasing by 2.50%, while Consumer Discretionary was the weakest sector falling (3.54%) on the week.

MARKET NEWS

Canada

Employment rose 54K in July according to the Labour Force survey thanks to an 82K surge in part-time jobs that more than made up for a 28K decline in the full-time segment. Jobs in the public sector jumped 49.6K while gains in private employment was a more subdued (+5K). On a regional basis, employment was up in Ontario (+61K) and British Columbia (+11K) while Quebec (-8K) and Alberta (-4K) experienced declines.

Housing Starts fell to an annualized rate of 206.3K units in July from 246.2K in June. At the provincial level, urban starts retraced significantly in both Ontario (-35.0K to 65.7K) and Quebec (-15.1K to 33.9K).

United States

The Consumer Price Index e rose 0.2%m/m, matching consensus expectations. Energy prices fell 0.5% while food costs edged up 0.1%. Excluding these two categories, core CPI also advanced 0.2% as prices for ex energy services and ex-energy commodities progressed 0.3% and 0.1% respectively.
